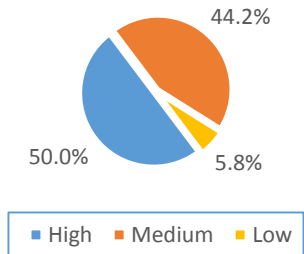




The Halifax Tool Library Public Engagement Survey

Over the last few months the Halifax Tool Library has gone all over Halifax discussing the possibility of a Halifax Tool Library with our communities. Overall, with online and in-person survey responses, we collected feedback from over **390** people! Here's some of what we heard:

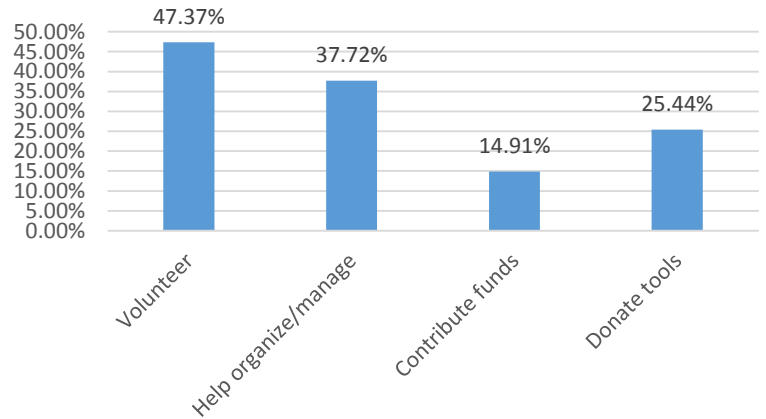
Level of Interest (n=344)



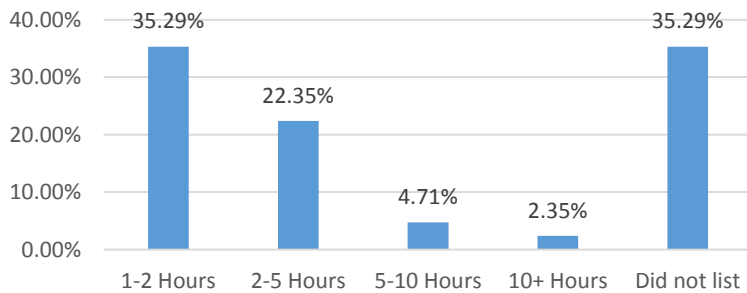
The community liked the idea, with half of respondents expressing high interest!

Volunteer Interest, Hours per week (n=85)

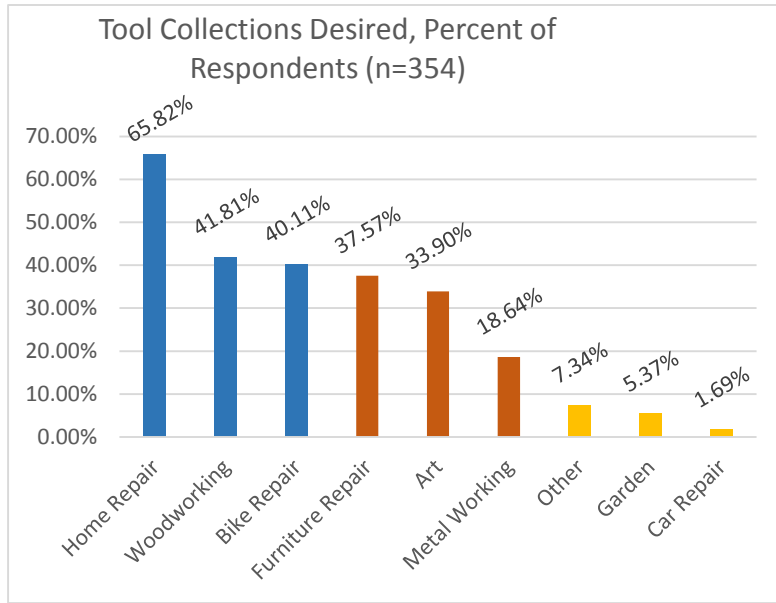


Of those willing to volunteer, small time commitments are better, but many are interested.

All told, the group reported **225** hours of potential volunteering a week!

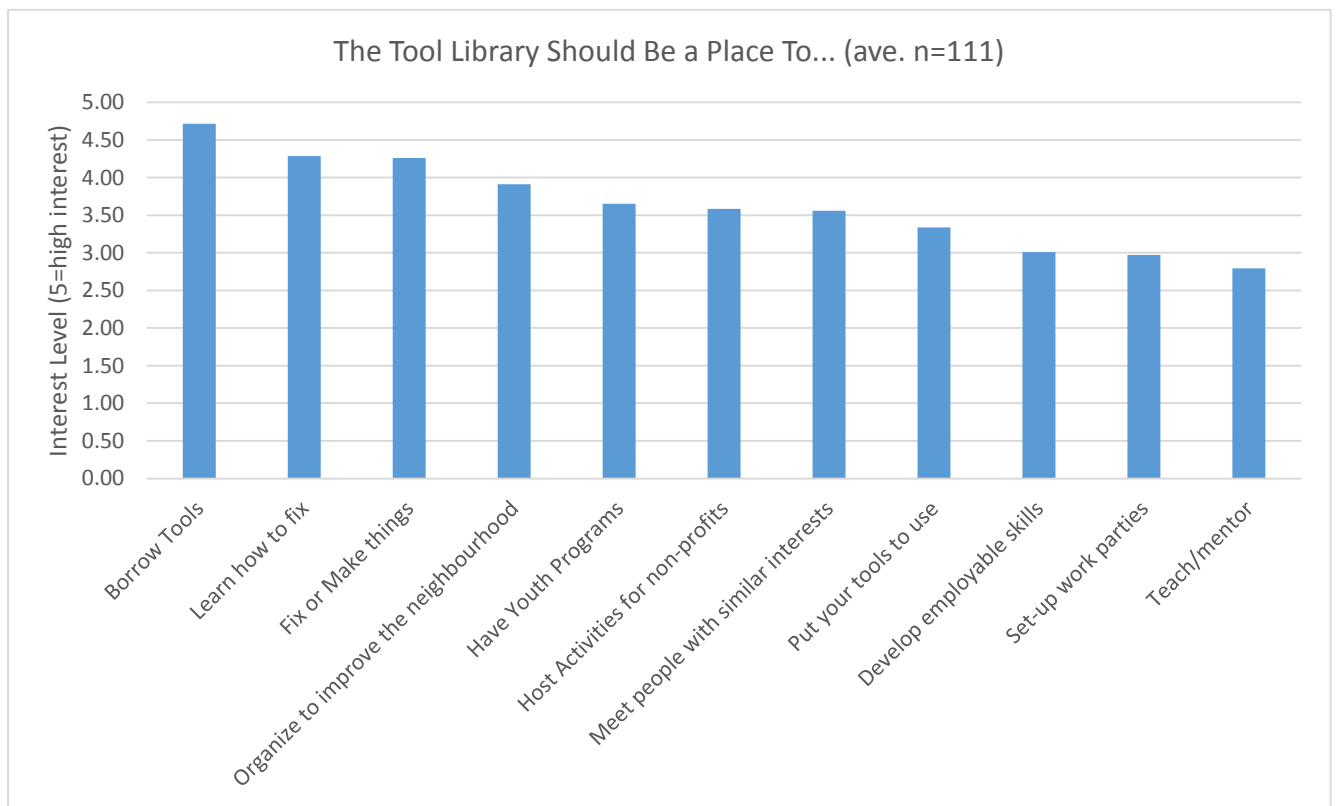


The Halifax Tool Library Public Engagement Survey

However, the standout need for the tool library is to have a collection capable of supporting Home Repair

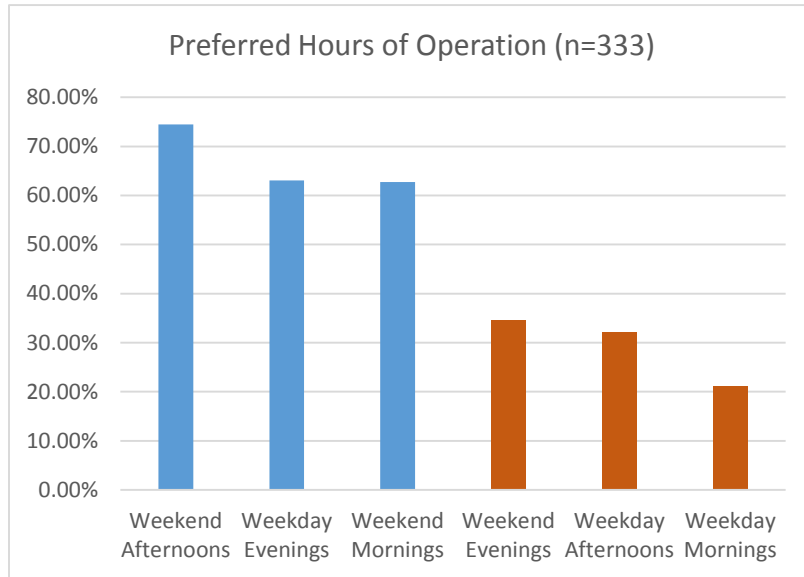


The Tool Library needs to be a place capable of supporting many things as there is fairly high interest in diverse activities such as supporting non-profits and youth.
